About This Course

This course provides enhanced life-saving skills and qualifications well beyond the standard First Aid course.

The Provide Advanced Resuscitation and Oxygen Therapy (HLTAID015) course is a comprehensive course that builds further on a participant's foundational knowledge.

The course describes the skills and knowledge required to use specialised equipment in the provision of resuscitation and oxygen therapy in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) guidelines.

It covers the essential topics such as CPR techniques, anaphylaxis and asthma management, incident reporting, and advanced first aid equipment usage.

Further, it teaches critical skills for assessing and managing casualties, dealing with shock and cardiac conditions, and administering oxygen therapy effectively, including advanced techniques like suction device usage and airway management.

This unit applies to persons who may be required to use specialised equipment to provide resuscitation or oxygen therapy in

a range of complex situations, including community and workplace settings.

Training Standards

Participant Requirements

Participants require a Unique Student Identifier (USI), a number required under government legislation for anyone undertaking accredited Vocational Education and Training (VET). Obtaining a USI is free. To apply for a USI, visit: https://www.usi.gov.au/

Participants require general literacy and numeracy skills, and a moderate level of fitness.

Physical tasks involve performing at least two minutes of CPR (five cycles of chest compressions and breaths) on an adult resuscitation mannequin placed on the floor and perform at least two minutes of CPR (five cycles of chest compressions and breaths) on an infant resuscitation mannequin placed on a firm surface.

Participants at face-to-face learning should wear in comfortable clothing, nothing too loose, long pants and enclosed shoes.

For online learning, internet and computer access is required, along with general computer skills. The computer must be able to play audio.

Where applicable, participants must have completed any required pre-course online learning and assessment prior to attending face-to-face training.

Participants must be aged 14 or over. Participants aged 14–17 require written consent from a parent or legal guardian.

If a participant is suffering any transmittable illness (flu, common cold,

Covid, etc), please do not attend the training to avoid impacting other participants.

Course Formats

Full Course: The full course is required for those who don't hold a current Statement of Attainment (i.e. They have never completed the accredited course, or it has been more than three years since completing the course and their qualifications have lapsed).

Refresher Course: This is available for those who have a current Statement of Attainment that is less than three years old and near expiry.



Course Delivery

Courses are predominantly delivered on a face-to-face basis at our training rooms at Oxley, south-west Brisbane, which can cater for up to 30 participants.

Where applicable, there may be some prereading and learning required, or units of online learning. Learner guides are provided.

By prearrangement, training can be conducted offsite at your business premises, educational facility, community



hall, or government office. Please contact us to discuss.

This course includes:

 6 hours of face to face learning followed by 3hrs and 30mins assessment face to face.

Our training facilities (Oxley) include plenty of free off-street parking.

Assessment

The course includes assessments of practical skills and a written questionnaire.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is not offered for this course due to the need to learn up-to-date methodologies and demonstrate competencies to ensure high level upskilling.

Course Outcomes

The Provide Advanced Resuscitation and Oxygen Therapy (HLTAID015) course teaches a wide range of instruction on providing First Aid to a greater number of medical conditions and illnesses.

Each candidate will demonstrate skills in an environment that provides realistic indepth, scenarios and simulations to assess candidates' skills and knowledge.

This course covers skills and knowledge in the following areas:

Respond to an emergency situation

- Recognise and assess an emergency situation.
- Ensure safety for self, bystanders and casualty.
- Assess the casualty and recognise the need for CPR, advanced resuscitation response or oxygen therapy.
- Manage life-threatening bleeding.
- Seek assistance from emergency services.
- Ensure environment is safe for delivery of oxygen.

Perform resuscitation procedures

- Perform single-rescuer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) or two-rescuer resuscitation procedures, including use of oxygen, in accordance with the ARC guidelines and availability of rescuers.
- Display respectful behaviour towards casualty.
- Use available resources and equipment according to manufacturers' instructions.

<u>Deliver oxygen therapy</u>

- Identify need for oxygen therapy, including by using a pulse oximeter.
- Use appropriate delivery device to provide oxygen.



 Monitor casualty condition and rectify issues preventing adequate treatment.

Communicate details of the incident

- Accurately convey incident details to emergency services.
- Report details of incident in line with appropriate workplace or site procedures.
- Complete applicable workplace or site documentation, including incident report form.
- Maintain privacy and confidentiality of information in line with statutory or organisational policies.

Review the incident

- Recognise the possible psychological impacts on self and other rescuers and seek help when required.
- Contribute to a review of the first aid response as required.
- Check, maintain and clean equipment ready for future use.
