Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site (HLTAID013)

About This Course

This course provides the skills required to deliver First Aid and CPR and manage the unique challenges that often accompany the delivery of First Aid and CPR at remote and isolated locations.

This course includes and expands on the skills learned in the Provide First Aid (HLTAID011) course.

It describes the skills and knowledge required to provide a First Aid response to a casualty in a remote or isolated site over an extended period of time until medical assistance is provided, or evacuation occurs.

First aid is to be provided in line with guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies.

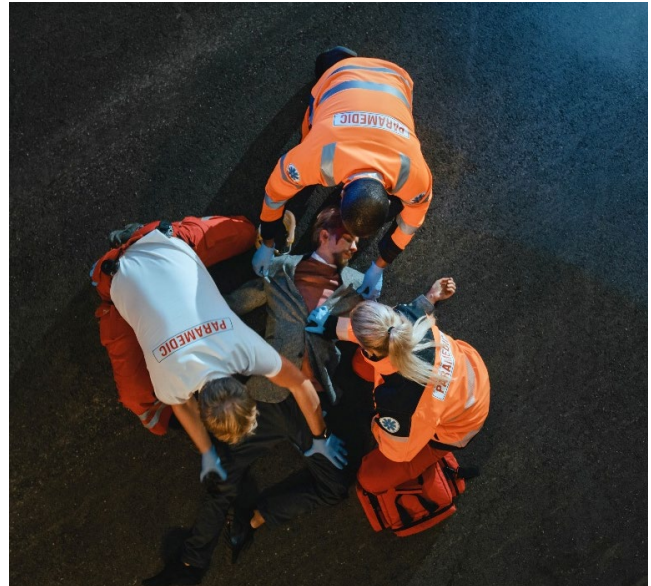
The course is suitable for those responsible for delivering First Aid in vocations including mining, large scale and outback farming, outdoor recreation that includes bushwalking and kayaking, remote tourism, response and rescue, and other vocations.

The course Learn how to manage an aero-medical evacuation, the use of different communications equipment, consider the impacts of various terrain like desert, alpine, marine or tropical environments.

The course will equip you to confidently apply first aid skills in line with the guidelines of the Australian Resuscitation

Council (ARC), workplace procedures and first aid codes of practice.

This is a two-day course.



Training Standards

Qualifications

Upon successful completion of the Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site course, Public Safety Training & Response Group will issue participants with a Statement of Attainment under the Australian

Qualifications Framework for the following accredited units:

- HLTAID013 – Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site.

The course incorporates the following accredited units:

- HLTAID009 – Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation
- HLTAID010 – Provide Basic Emergency Life Support
- HLTAID011 – Provide First Aid



Participant Requirements

Participants require a Unique Student Identifier (USI), a number required under government legislation for anyone undertaking accredited Vocational Education and Training (VET). Obtaining a USI is free. To apply for a USI, visit: <https://www.usi.gov.au/>

Participants require general literacy and numeracy skills, and a moderate level of fitness.

Participants at face-to-face learning should wear in comfortable clothing,

nothing too loose, long pants and enclosed shoes.

For online learning, internet and computer access is required, along with general computer skills. The computer must be able to play audio.

Where applicable, participants must have completed any required pre-course online learning and assessment prior to attending face-to-face training.

Participants must be aged 14 or over. Participants aged 14–17 require written consent from a parent or legal guardian.

If a participant is suffering any transmittable illness (flu, common cold, Covid, etc), please do not attend the training to avoid impacting other participants.

Course Formats

Full Course: The full Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site course is required for those who don't hold a current Statement of Attainment (i.e. They have never completed an accredited Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site course, or it has been more than three years since completing the course and their qualifications have lapsed).

Refresher Course: This is available for those who have a current Statement of Attainment that is less than three years old and near expiry.

Courses are offered on a face-to-face training room basis with some elements of online learning available.



Course Delivery

Courses are predominantly delivered on a face-to-face basis at our training rooms at Oxley, south-west Brisbane, which can cater for up to 30 participants.

Where applicable, there may be some pre-reading and learning required, or units of online learning. Learner guides are provided.



By prearrangement, training can be conducted offsite at your business premises, educational facility, community hall, or government office. Please contact us to discuss.

This course includes:

- 16 hours face to face learning and 6-hour face-to-face practical session.

Our training facilities (Oxley) include plenty of free off-street parking.

Assessment

The course includes assessments of practical skills and a written questionnaire.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is not offered for this course due to the need to learn up-to-date methodologies and demonstrate current competencies to ensure high level upskilling.

Course Outcomes

The Provide First Aid in remote or isolated site (HLTAID013) course teaches a wide range of instruction on the additional skills required to overcome the unique challenges of providing First Aid in remote and isolated locations.

Each candidate will demonstrate skills in an environment that provides realistic in-depth, scenarios and simulations to assess candidates' skills and knowledge.

Course topics include:

- All requirements consistent with prerequisite qualifications (HLTAID011 – Provide First Aid, HLTAID009 – Provide Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, HLTAID010 – Provide Basic Emergency Life Support)



- Prepare equipment for first aid response in remote or isolated site.
- Assess the situation.
- Apply appropriate first aid procedures.
- Communicate details of the incident to emergency services and others,
- Considerations of unique factors, including: the nature of remote or isolated sites and how this may impact on first aid management, and key features, functions and limitations of different types of emergency communication equipment used in remote or isolated sites and factors that affect choice: radio equipment, mobile phones, satellite phones, alerting and tracking devices including personal locator beacons (PLBs)
- Coordinate evacuation and/or first aid activities until assistance arrives, and methods used to assist emergency services to locate incident sites, such as verbal directions, flags, flares or smoke, fires, etc
- Use of man-made and natural resources to supplement first aid equipment, understand the content of remote area first aid kits and remote area medication boxes,
- Review the incident. Understand psychological impacts of first aid incidents on rescuers and how to seek help.
